	Sunglasses or range glasses
	Safety vest / bullet proof vest
	Dry Cleaning / washing

	Guns (any guns)
	Ammo and reload gear
	Targets and range fees
	Duty belt and accessories
	Flashlight and holder
	Badge and badge case
	Holster
	Duty bag
	First Aid kit
	Emergency equipment – lights, sirens, radio, scanner
	Hand cuffs and keys
	Gun safes – home and vehicle
